- The competition will be held under Swim England Regulations and technical rules of racing Level 3.License 3EM240852
 Officials will be from Regional lists of the Swim England
- 2. All Events shall have heat declared winners, except the skins. Session lengths are a Maximum of 7.5 hours per day
- 3. The events are:-

50m all 4 strokes all age groups 100m all 4 strokes all age groups 200m all 4 strokes & 200IM all age groups 400m Free & 400IM all age groups <u>except 9 years</u> (Max entries, 36 in 400 Free and 30 in 400 IM) Medley Skins based on 13yrs and under & 14yrs and over, Male/Open or Female.

- 4. The age groups shall be 9,10,11,12,13,14yrs, and 15yrs and over. **Age as at 17th November 2024**
- 5. The pool length is 25m, six lanes, and will be equipped with Ares electronic timing with full display and anti wave lane ropes.
- 6. Awards will be given to the **top six** placed swimmers in each age group in each individual event. Awards will be made to all Male/Open and Female Skins competitors. There will be awards for the Top Male/Open and Top Female These awards will be determined by awarding points 6 5 4 3 2 1 in each age group, in each event swum. Skins: Selection is made from Top 6 in 200IM for both 13 and under and 14 and over categories. Heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times.

Entries must be equal to or slower than the published upper limit times for each event. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

If similar amounts of entries are not received for each session, the start time of the later sessions on each day may be subject to change (earlier or later) and will be confirmed with entry information on the website

- 7. Over the top starts may be used at the promoter's discretion.
- 8. There is **no secondary strobe available** at this meet.
- 9. The entry fee is £8.00 per event for **electronic entry via the sportsystem entry manager ONLY. Absolutely** no entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to promoters' error or omission.
- 10. All accepted entries will be confirmed on the website for the relevant swimmers/clubs to check.
- 11. Clubs with more than 10 swimmers are asked to provide a licensed technical official to assist with the operation of the meet. We also accept officials who may be accompanying competitors
- 12. Any swimmer wishing to withdraw can do so by emailing the open meet secretary at mscopenmeets@gmail.com by Friday 15th November 2024 no later than 9-00pm. Swimmers wishing to withdraw from an event on the day of the meet must do so prior to the start of the warm up session in which the event is due to be swum.

- 13. To assist in the smooth running of the meet and for the best interest of all competitors, if, after the closing date you do not intend to compete in one or all of the events, please help your fellow swimmers by completing the withdrawal form.
- 14. Reimbursements for unaccepted entries are to be returned via your club secretary. No refunds will be made for the cancellation of accepted entries after the closing date.
- 15. Closing date for all entries is 18th October 2024
- 16. Results will be computer processed. These will be available on our web site shortly after the meet.
- 17. **Spectator admission prices**:
 Both Days Adults £7.00 per session / £9.00 for the day
 Children; £2.00 for the day
- 18. Poolside passes are available to bona fide Coaches/Team managers supporting competing swimmers. Coaches AND Team managers MUST have a pass to be on poolside and must be DBS checked and Safeguard trained One day £15, Two day £25. Passes must be ordered along with the entry file, and collected on the day of the meet from "front of house". For reasons of Child Protection, these will not be sold on the day. If changing personnel during the day, this MUST be done front of house and not on poolside. Please return passes on the Saturday at end of session.
- For the purposes of Child Protection, at any time. In line with Swim England and Watermeadows guidelines,
 poolside photography is not permitted except for the Meet Licensed Official Photographer,
 - Electronic devices must not be used on poolside or in the changing rooms.
- 20. For reasons of Health and Safety, please note that restricted spectator entry to the viewing gallery at all times commences as warm up for each session begins, chairs are strictly prohibited within the spectator area, spectator numbers will be limited as per the guidance from Water Meadows,. We will follow the current guidance for competitions from Swim England for the safe running of this competition.
- 21. The promoters reserve the right to delay the start of a session to allow swimmers a safe and adequate warm up.
- 22. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters Mansfield Swimming Club. All entries and enquiries should be emailed to:
